Project highlights include the iconic Gateway Center MTA Headquarters, a 28-story office building in downtown Los Angeles; the Grand Park Redevelopment Project; The Emerson, a 20-story high-rise residential tower; The Village at Santa Monica, a new 324-unit residential and retail development with a three-level, below-grade parking garage; and the County of Los Angeles' San Fernando Valley Family Support Center, a new 212,000 SF office building and a new 1,326-car Parking Structure. Throughout his career, Dave Eichten has actively supported the advancement of construction industry education. He currently serves on the Advisory Committee at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo and is a Board Member of DBIA-WPR. Dave holds a B.S. in Construction Management from California Polytechnic, San Luis Obispo and is a LEED Accredited Professional.
