The Castlewood Country Club

In 2016, Castlewood Country Club celebrated the 90th Anniversary of the Hill Golf Course, one of two 18-hole championship golf courses. The two courses offer very different golfing experiences. The Hill Course, designed by William P. Bell, features a variety of elevation, phenomenal views of the valley below and requires focus to conquer this challenging course. The Valley Course is a great course to walk, and is a challenge due to its length, topography and rapid greens.

With a rich history, founded by the Hearst Family, Castlewood is a place where memories are created and treasured. The Hearst Family donated this land to the Club to create a place where their dreams of luxury, sportsmanship, and camaraderie could be enjoyed and carried on for generations. Castlewood's pride is in its golf courses however Castlewood also offers tennis courts and tournaments, a large swimming pool which hosts the Barracuda Swim Team, bocce leagues in Spring and Fall, dining experiences in three different restaurants and a variety of member events throughout the year.

Castlewood Country Club is very conveniently located just off Interstate 680 in Pleasanton, California. We are easily accessible from all major freeways, and within a 35 minute drive time from most major points in the San Francisco Bay Area.

FROM THE NORTH

Take 680 South then exit at Sunol Blvd/Castlewood Drive. Turn right at the end of the ramp, take the first right onto Castlewood Drive. Follow Castlewood Drive past our Valley Course continuing straight after reaching the 1st stop sign, crossing Foothill Road past the entrance walls. Veer slightly to your left and follow the signs up the hill to the Main Clubhouse, and Hill Pro Shop.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take 680 North, exit at Sunol Blvd in Pleasanton. Turn left at the exit and pass under the Interstate and take the first right onto Castlewood Drive. Follow Castlewood Drive past our Valley Course continuing straight after reaching the 1st stop sign, crossing Foothill Road past the entrance walls. Veer slightly to your left and follow the signs up the hill to the Main Clubhouse, Hill Pro Shop.
