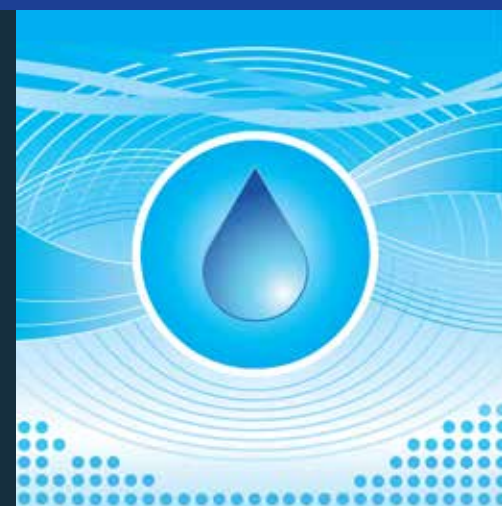

The City of Santa Monica has leveraged Progressive Design-Build (PDB) for nearly two decades to deliver several large capital improvement projects, including a \$96 million potable reuse facility and \$72 million expansion of its groundwater desalter to achieve water self-sufficiency by 2023. The presentation will provide an owner's perspective on benefits of PDB delivery (e.g., key process equipment selection, risk mitigation, and performance guarantees), tips and lessons learned for others considering the PDB model.
