Join DBIA-WPR Sacramento Chapter for a webinar. Research by the [Construction Industry Rehabilitation Plan](#), a Canadian organization, found that 83% of construction workers north of the border have experienced some form of moderate to severe mental health issue. In the US, a 2020 study by the CDC found that [men working in construction have one of the highest suicide rates](#) compared to other industries. Their suicide rate was about four times higher than the general population. These studies were from before the pandemic!!!

This is a crisis that we as an industry need to address with urgency. Please join DBIA-WPR Sacramento chapter to understand the significance of this crisis and programs some of our GC and Trade partners have developed to address it.
