In the U.S. sector, the federal government, as well as many states and local governments, employ design-build contracting for a significant percentage of their building programs.

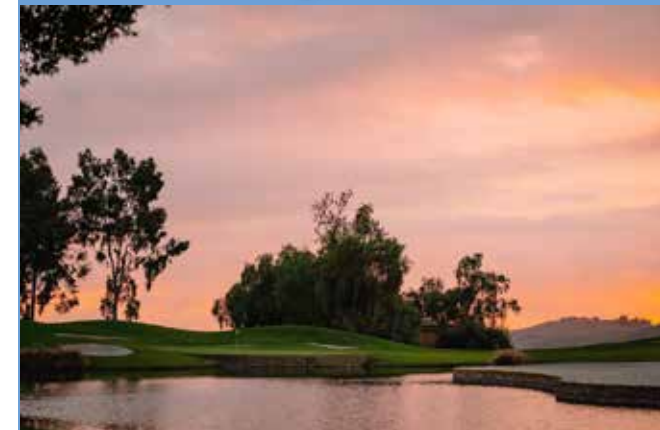
