He was the architect of record for the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism and Mass Communication, and Principal in Charge at HDR for the ISTB 4 laboratory building and "Chief Engineer" for the California Prison Receivership project. He recently represented the Del E. Webb School of Construction Users for the Block 12 Project at ASU. Mr. Jackson is an advocate for Integrated Project Delivery, Lean, the formation of High Performance Teams, and the creation of Knowledge Based Learning Organizations. He is also an advocate for advanced sustainable solutions for restorative architecture. Mr. Jackson often acts as a facilitator for companies and groups attempting to achieve exceptional results through collaboration, integration and innovation.
