All submissions **must include:**

- All submitted papers must follow the same format as requested during the online submission
- All submitted files must be labeled with the primary presenter firm/organization name
- Primary Presenter and Co-presenter(s) Name, Title, and Full Contact Information
  - Headshots as a jpeg for **all** presenters
  - Bio's (one page or less – preferably 500 words or less) for **all** presenters

***Submittals will not be accepted unless all items in the above guidelines are included.***

## PRESENTER AGREEMENTS

**All presenters must be in agreement with the following, prior to submitting:**

- The Primary Presenter to be prepared and agree to serve as the main point of contact, including coordination with co-presenters, and ensuring that each **presenter registers online for the full conference within 2 weeks of selection notification.**
- Presenters will be financially responsible for full conference registration and hotel fees.
- Conference registration for all presenters to be completed within 2 weeks of speaker selection notification.
