Craig Unger is Principal and CEO of Unger Security Solutions, LLC, providing consulting services for acquisition management, project delivery, and the security and detention environment.

Mr. Unger served as President of DBIA from 2003-4 and is a nationally recognized instructor, lecturer, and author on design-build procurement.

Before joining DBIA, Mr. Unger served

for 26 years at the US Department of Justice, primarily as the Procurement Executive for the Federal Bureau of Prisons where he led the Agency's design and construction program from a "low bid" approach to an integrated, design-build delivery system.

He also served as a design and construction consultant for the US State Department, and the US Army Corps of Engineers on various major federal projects, including US Embassies worldwide.
