SPEAKER: Mr. Roger Johnson, Deputy Executive Director - LAWA

Mr. Johnson has extensive experience in Engineering, Planning and Environmental Services. He has over 30 years experience in construction, construction management, environmental management, civil and environmental engineering and planning. For the past 25 years, Mr. Johnson's professional responsibilities have focused primarily on the transportation industry. He has held increasingly responsible management positions within the public and private sector over the past 25 years including Deputy Exec. Director of Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), and managing the aviation division for an international Engineering, Planning and Environmental consulting firm. He has provided technical services to over 150 airports across the United States, Europe and Asia. In his current position overseeing the Airports Development Group for LAWA, Mr. Johnson is responsible for management of over \$5 billion in capital improvements. Prior to taking responsibility for the Development Program, Mr. Johnson was LAWA's Deputy Executive Director for Facilities and Environmental Planning. Mr. Johnson's duties included oversight of all Engineering, Planning, Facilities, Regional Transportation Planning and Environmental Planning for the four airports owned by the City of Los Angeles. Mr. Johnson has been with LAWA since 2006, and also served an earlier stint with LAWA from 2000-2003 as Deputy Executive Director for Technology and Environmental Affairs. Mr. Johnson's other professional experience includes serving as the VP and Technical Services Manager for CDM Inc. Working with CDM from 1987-2000 and again from 2003-2006, he was responsible for management of the Aviation, Planning and Environmental Services Division, provided technical oversight, staffing, and project delivery support for aviation projects in the US, Europe and Asia. In addition, Mr. Johnson personally managed engineering, planning and environmental projects for multiple aviation clients including Los Angeles World Airports, San Diego International Airport, Phoenix Sky Harbor International, Atlanta Hartsfield International Airport, New York John F. Kennedy International Airport, Newark International Airport, and Denver International Airport. Mr. Johnson graduated magna cum laude from California State Polytechnic University, Pomona with a B.S. in Engineering.
