LA Metro has utilized the design-build project delivery method for more than a decade and will continue to use design-build to implement critical transportation and transit projects. Currently they have over \$6Bil in design-build projects in various stages of procurement, design and construction. K.N. Murthy and Bryan Pennington are senior managers at LA Metro and have extensive experience in implementing design-build contracts for complex heavy civil construction projects. They will discuss how to evaluate the optimal use of design-build and how they procure these large projects.
