SPEAKERS

REBEKAH G. GLADSON, FAIA - President, rggrouop



Ms. Gladson was the Associate Vice Chancellor and Campus Architect for the University of California, Irvine for 20 years and was responsible for managing over 4.9 billion (current dollars) of public works projects ranging from a \$60 M co-gen chiller plant expansion to a \$650M hospital including the design, contracting, construction and inspection. In 2008 she established rggrouop which provides consultation to public owners on building integrated teams and utilizing innovative project delivery processes. Ms. Gladson has spearheaded the broad acceptance of highly successful Design-Build processes for design and construction of public project within UC and in the State of CA. Through her efforts, UCI and public owners have become known in the industry for best value delivery of projects and as active advocates in the use of partnering and other tools for promoting innovation, added value and industry best practices of BIM and lean construction practices. At UCI, Ms. Gladson was responsible for overseeing \$4.9 billion (current dollars) in design and construction. Under Ms. Gladson's leadership of Design & Construction Services, UCI has received national and regional awards for design and building excellence. In 2006, UCI was named Owner of the Year by the ASA and Ms. Gladson was honored with the Brunelleschi Lifetime Achievement Award from DBIA, as well as the Client Achievement Honor Award from the AIACC. In 2008, Rebekah Gladson received the coveted S.I.R. Award from AGC of California. Sought after for her expertise, Ms. Gladson frequently lectures at, and consults with both public and private owners, medical center, universities and professional organizations throughout the U.S. and abroad, focusing on alternative construction delivery methods, managing the implementation of capital programs, and leadership and strategic problem-solving. Her Keynote Address to the Asia Bridge Summit 2008 in Shanghai, China, introduced critical new concepts to this international conference of design and construction professionals. Immediate Past Chair of the National Board for the DBIA, Ms. Gladson serves on the boards of various professional and academic institutions. Ms. Gladson holds a Masters of Architecture from Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo, and certificates from the Institute for Executive Leadership and Management at Stanford University and the University of California Management Institute. In 2008, Ms. Gladson was elected to the College of Fellows of the AIA.

JACOB WILLIAMS - Assistant Director, Los Angeles County Department of Public Works



Mr. Williams is responsible for the management and delivery of the LA County Capital Projects Program currently valued in excess of \$3 billion. Jacob has led the County in a paradigm shift from traditional low-bid delivery to more advanced and integrated project delivery methods such as Design-Build on a diverse array of project types including Health, Sheriff, Probation, Fire, Libraries, Information Technology, Parks & Recreation, Beaches, and Admin. During his 25-year career with the County, Jacob has served in a variety of senior executive positions and has been responsible directing and administering a wide array of Department business functions. Prior to joining County Public Works, Jacob served as a Project Manager and Principal Project Manager for the County's Internal Services Department from 1984 to 1995, where he headed the Northridge Earthquake Recovery program and managing the \$200 million Century Regional Justice Center. Jacob received a Bachelor of Architecture degree from UC Berkeley. He is a CA licensed Architect with over 25 years of professional experience in architecture, project management, planning, and the administration of Capital Projects. The LA County Public Works Dept. is the largest public works agency in the US, with an annual budget over two billion dollars.
