Lou has been the Assistant Director of Department of General Services at SD County since 2007. The Department responsibilities include facilities management for more than 8M sqft in 1,100 County facilities, capital project planning, construction, energy/utility program management, real estate purchases, sales, leasing, and rights for over 45,000 acres of County land, and acquisition and maintenance of the County's 4.000 vehicle fleet. Lou has been instrumental in developing the use of Design-Build as the primary method for construction of Capital Projects for the County. The county has successfully accomplished nearly 1B dollars of major construction projects utilizing Design-Build. Lou holds a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from UC Davis and is a licensed CA Civil Engineer.

Robin Tsuchida, Senior Director, Project Management, UC SAN DIEGO

Robin joined UCSD in 2012 as a Principal Architect and was appointed the position of Senior Director, Project Management of Campus Projects for Capital Program Management in 2017. Robin is responsible for strategic management of campus architectural design and construction of capital projects. She has been a leader on various projects over the past several years including the integration of the light rail into the campus, Gilman Bridge, Structural Materials and Engineering Building, Galbraith Hall Renovation which repurposed the original campus library and multiple housing and dining projects. Current efforts include innovative implementation of planned capital projects at UCSD including academic research, housing and fully integrating the light rail transit into the campus.
