



SMUD EAST CAMPUS OPERATIONS CENTER - NET ZERO, NO ADDED COST

The Sacramento Municipal Utilities District (SMUD) East Campus Operations Center is a \$111 million project that consolidated current corporate yard functions into a new 300,000 square foot facility on a 51-acre site that includes a six-story office building, equipment repair shops, fuel, maintenance, open storage space, warehouse, and fleet parking. The project successfully utilized the Design-Build method to achieve a LEED Platinum goal with a heavy emphasis on renewable energy sources and Net Zero energy usage.

Mr. Norwood has been with SMUD since 1990. For the past 15 years he has been in the Facilities Dept. with engineering, energy management and project management responsibilities. He is a registered Mechanical Engineer and a LEED Accredited Professional. In 2007, he achieved LEED-EB Platinum Certification for SMUD's Customer Service Center in Sacramento. In 2009 he began working as Technical Manager of the East Campus-Operations Center. This is a LEED-NC Platinum project and, at 350,000 sq. ft., it is the country's 2nd largest Zero-Net-Energy site. He is currently the project manager for the remodel of SMUD's 53-year-old Headquarters Building.

A graduate of the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee with a B.S. in Architecture, Mr. Schultz has spent the past 13 years with Turner Construction's Sacramento office. Projects include the \$286M Sacramento International Airport Airside Terminal, \$210M New Stockton Courthouse, \$56M Caltrans District 3 HQ (design build), and the \$111M SMUD East Operations Center (design build). He previously worked for Vanir, Kitchell, Fluor, and Morse Diesel over his 30 year career.
