David is responsible for the oversight of all UNLV campus physical planning, design, construction and related FF&E activities at the UNLV Maryland Campus, Shadow Lane Campus and proposed North Campus, as well as participation in planning, design, construction and FF&E activities at the UNLV Harry Reid Research Park, working with a staff of design, construction, management and administrative professionals, and a variety of student interns and workers. David received his Bachelor of Architecture degree with honors from Carnegie Mellon University and currently or previously has held architectural licenses in Nevada, Massachusetts, Utah, Idaho, Florida, Arizona, Texas and Oregon. He also has served as an Adjunct Instructor of Architecture at the UNLV School of Architecture, as President of AIA Nevada and Las Vegas Chapters, as the Chair of the AIA National Public Architects Knowledge Committee, as a member of the Editorial Board of Architecture Las Vegas magazine. Related to activities and services specifically in the design-build sector, David oversaw the first UNLV design-build project in the institution's history - the UNLV Advanced Dental Education Building, served as co-chair of the 2013 DBIA National Conference Planning Committee, a juror at the 2013 DBIA National Student Design-Build Competition, a juror for the DBIA WPR Design-Build Awards Program from 2010 through 2015, and as a Panelist for the DBIA 2010 National Convention Closing General Session related to Owner Expectations of Design-Build.
